Policy statement

In the event of any of the following exceptional circumstances, Rainbow Pre-school may not be able to open, or may have to close a daily session early.

- Power failure

- No heating during cold weather
- No hot or running water
- Staff sickness
- Security/safety warnings e.g. fire, gas leak
- Epidemic, following advice from the Infection Control Unit.
