Rainbow's Committee

As you may be aware the Pre School has a Parent Committee who volunteer their time to organise various fundraising events and activities throughout the year alongside the Aunties.

We want to stress the importance of the Committee and introduce you to the Chair, Treasurer and Secretary.

The Committee are responsible for the management of the Pre School and all associated liabilities. All decisions on the operations of the setting are the responsibility of the Committee. The Committee can delegate the implementation of some decisions to staff, but will still retain their responsibility.

As a constituted (Committee run) setting which is registered with the Charity Commision, we have charitable status and must abide by Charity Law and our Constitution. Our Constitution is the set of rules by which we operate as a charity. The Constitution must be re-adopted annually at the Annual General Meeting.

Should the Committee not contain enough parent volunteers, then the Pre School would close. The Committee has to have a Chair, Treasurer, Secretary and at least 2 other members.
